Work Opportunity Tax Credit

[WOTC](#) is a federal tax credit available to employers for hiring individuals from certain targeted groups. Credits range from \$1,200 to \$9,600, based on the target group and number of hours worked.

[Apprenticeships](#) offer employers a pipeline of qualified, motivated applicants trained in the skills they need to be successful.

On-the-Job Training

[On-the-Job Training](#) is a federally funded program that helps employers hire and train individuals for long-term employment. Employers can get:

- Help recruiting and screening employees
- Help developing a skilled workforce
- Reimbursement for a percentage of the trainee's wages during the training period

TechCred

[TechCred](#) helps employers build a stronger workforce by offering reimbursement for up to \$2,000 for each industry-recognized, technology-focused credential an employee earns.

Incumbent Worker Training

The Ohio Incumbent Workforce Training Voucher Program reimburses eligible employers for the costs of upskilling employees.

Rapid Response

Rapid Response services offer layoff aversion and early intervention services to employers who are facing downsizing or layoffs.

SharedWork Ohio

[SharedWork Ohio](#) is a voluntary layoff aversion program. It allows workers to remain employed and employers to retain trained staff during times of reduced business activity. Employers can uniformly reduce employees' hours, and employees can receive a weekly benefit.
